Topic: Children coaching, Coaching ethics/integrity, bridging the gap between sport science /Technology and coaching practice (best practice)

Abstract title: Building a culture for sharing competence.

The Norwegian Ski Federation works towards a goal of bringing focus on development into all levels in our organization.

We believe building a culture for sharing competence is important to reach this goal.

The Norwegian Ski Federation will share best practice from what we are doing in our ski-clubs and the connection between children sports to the top athletes in the national teams and the relationship to our education programs.

Organization and Authors

The Norwegian Ski Federation with 1150 clubs and 170 000 members won 28 medals in the Pyeongchang Olympic Games, 2018 (11 Gold medals, 10 Silver medals and 7 Bronze medals).

All members of the coaching education team (below) have coached athletes who have won gold medals from the Olympic Games in Albertville 1992 to the Olympic Games in Pyeongchang 2018.

In 2018 this team delivered 964 courses through our education system to 12 000 coaches.
